Dear New Customer,

Trash dumpsters are placed primarily in alleys around town. The trash charge on your utility bill permits you to use any of these dumpsters for disposal of normal household trash. No used motor oil or similar substances may be thrown away in a dumpster.

Please be advised that the town does have a large roll-off dumpster for regular household items that do not fit in the regular trash dumpsters. This roll-off is for paying customers only. You may dispose of large items such as furniture. This roll-off is not intended for construction, demolition, renovation, or other sizeable projects; these will require you to secure your own waste disposal solution.

No tires of any kind or hazardous chemicals are allowed in the roll-off. Do not stack items above the top of the roll-off. Do not leave trash or debris on the ground.

The roll-off is located at the corner of Smith and Broadway streets, next to the city shop. This roll-off is provided by the town in compliance with our ordinance on Utilities, Section 16-110. The fee for violation of this ordinance is \$200.00.

Additionally, the city shop has a burn pile for tree limbs only. No large tree stumps, or wooden items with nails or staples permitted. Burning tumbleweeds or other items on your own property must be approved by the Hardesty Fire Department, and is only permitted when the county does not have an active burn ban.
